INSPIRE #2 - NEHEMIAH:

Today is the second message from our inspire series. It's the story of Nehemiah and how he faced some really big challenges. He was given a task by God to restore the wall in Jerusalem. It was a big project. At first it was going great but then everyone became disheartened. He found a way through this discouragement and his leadership speaks to us today. He dealt with all the fatigue, frustration and fear of the workers.

He adapted and reorganised the defence of the wall and the protection of those involved in building it. He reminded everyone that God is great and in control. Lastly, he encouraged them not just to resist the opposition but to make a stand and fight. When we move forward with God, often the evil one will attack us.
