BAPTISM:

We join in celebration with all those who are being baptised this morning. Baptism is of great importance because Jesus commanded it. We must carry out Christ's commands for they are based on wisdom and love, for the salvation of the human race. The church is called by God to teach the commands of Christ, to make disciples, and to baptise those disciples. This is to be done everywhere, in all nations, until the very end of the age. We are to baptise believers in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, for the one true God is a Holy Trinity (Three persons in one God and one God in three persons).

Acts 2:38-41 - 38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptised, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call." 40 With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." 41 Those who accepted his message were baptised, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.
