

GETTING BACK ON SPIRITUAL TRACK #3 - THE HIGH PLACES:

We're in a series on getting in shape spiritually. What we're calling getting back on spiritual track. It's a journey through an interesting section of the Bible, two books, I and II Kings. Today we come to number three. A high place was a shrine that was actually in a high place, on a hill or mountain-top, which is why pagan cultures imagined the gods living on the hill tops, living in the clouds, or residing on the peaks of mountains. As a result, it was common to establish shrines or altars to those gods on the high places.

It seems that all these kings, these leaders wanted to do the right thing but could not give up this last area of their old life. Their old ways. They wanted to hang onto this last pocket of spiritual territory no matter what. This means that God didn't have all of their lives. This led to an ongoing spiritual contamination that prevented them being fully and wholly devoted to God.

This morning if you have high places or other issues that have become strongholds in your life, you can be delivered from them. If the Holy Spirit has been pointing these out to you, you can be set free from them. Jesus already knows about them and longs for you to give them up so he can be truly Lord of your life.


