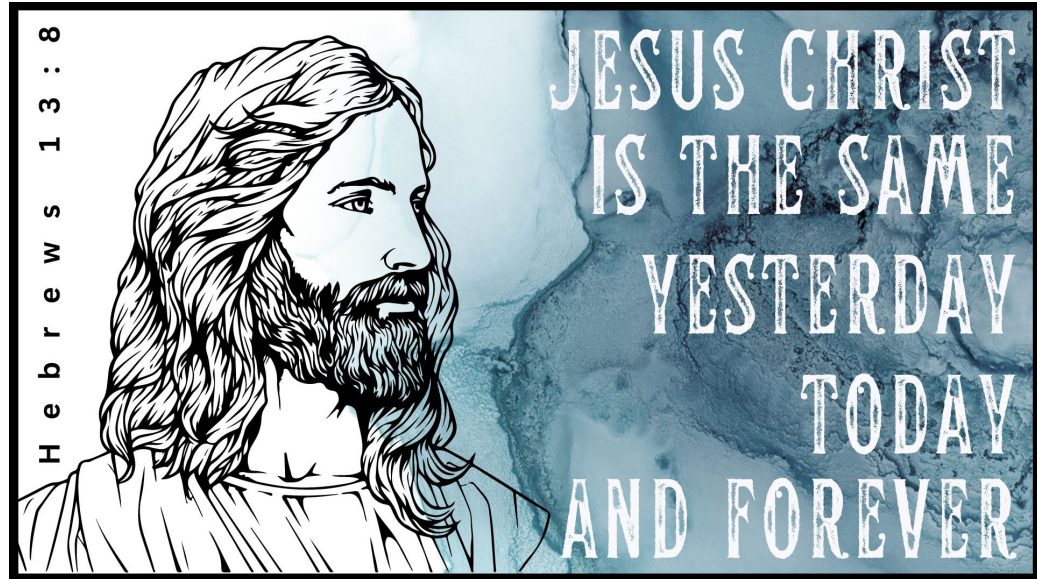

THE FLESH AND THE SPIRIT:

The book of Galatians, particularly chapters 3 - 6:11 highlights the contrasting the Apostle Paul refers to;

3:10 -14 Faith and works.

3:15 - 22 Abraham, Moses and Christ.

3: 23 - 28 Under the law and in Christ.

3: 28 - Jew - Greek, Slave - Free, Male - Female.

4:1 - 11 Once slaves but now Sons.

4:21 - 31 Issac and Ishmael.

5:11 - 12 False and True Religion.

5:16 - 25 Flesh and Spirit.

6:6 - 10 Sowing and Reaping.

Failure to live in spiritual perfection or better still to live a Christian life without sin was virtually impossible for the early church attendees located in Galatia. They had a daily struggle living by the law as outlined by Moses which you and I can read about in the first five books of the bible.

Here, in Chapter 5 of Galatians and the many other writings of Paul, give us a clear signpost of how we are to walk by the Spirit. Some bible renditions put it as 'walking in the Spirit' and others as 'Living by the Spirit.'

The early Christians were no strangers to sin and I have no doubt that as 21st century Christians we, like our early brothers and sisters, are no strangers to sin.

Today I want to share and preach about how the apostle Paul give us clear signage about walking by the Spirit.
